

# Jersey Wooly

— Fancy Breed —

## Posing the Jersey Wooly

Jersey Woolies are posed naturally, however check that they are not stretched out, lying down or flat on the table, ears are together and if necessary tuck the feet under the body. The coat should overlay downwards, not fluffed up as you would with English Angoras.

## Schedule of Points

(General Type: 50 points)

Body: 25 points

Head: 10 points

Ears: 8 points

Eyes: 2 points

Feet and legs: 4 points

Tail: 1 point

Wool: 35 points (texture 17, density 10, length 8 points)

Colour: 10 points

Condition: 5 points

Total 100 points



**Type:** short and compact body, shoulders slightly narrower than the hips, full and rounded hindquarters. The head is bold, well rounded and set close to the shoulders. Ears are erect and short 63 mm (2 ½ inches), well furred (without furnishings/tassels) and with slightly rounded tips.

**Coat:** evenly dense undercoat with generous overlay of thicker, heavier and longer guard hairs. Should have easy care qualities, unmated/felted, display a healthy lustre and full of life. Ideally 50 – 76 mm (2 to 3 inches) in length (minimum accepted is 1½ inches)

**Colours:** any colour/pattern is accepted, as long as it conforms to other breed standard colours/patterns.

**Adult weight:** ideal 1.360 kg (3lbs), Maximum 1.587 kg (3½ lbs)

**Faults:** long, narrow head and/or body, narrow shoulders or hips. Ears thin, crossed over or lacking in fur coverage. Coat excessively soft or coarse/harsh, thin, uneven, lacking in guard hair, excessive under wool, in moult or white hairs in solid colours.

**Disqualifications:** Ears over three inches long or having tassels, white toenails in coloureds, shorter coat than minimum length, skew tails, malocclusion, abnormalities, deformities, parasites and ill health. Changing/altering natural appearances, i.e. dying or trimming.

Other general faults and disqualifications that could be assessed and judged based on the severity in each case are: bare patches, overweight/overly fat, coat and eye colour discrepancies, illegible ring numbers, urine staining, underweight/poor condition, excessive dewlap, foreign colours and so on.
